Apple iPad Mini Versions – 7.9” screens

From £17.77 per month



- Perfect if you need the device for research only
- The smaller screen size does make it hard to be creative and type up your notes
- Options:
 - Different cases
 - 32GB or 64GB storage

Apple iPad Air 2 64GB – 9.7” screen

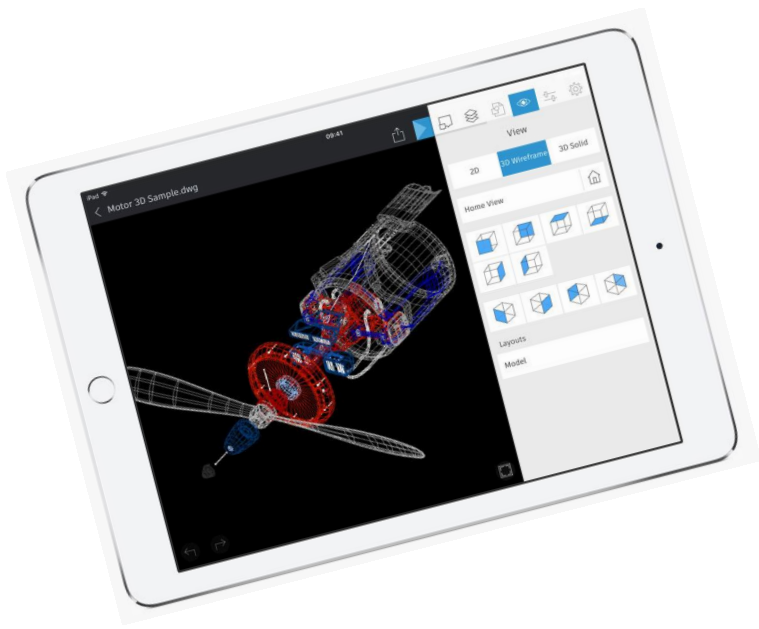
From £26.20 per month



- The device we suggest for the majority of students who want to research and view information
- Perfect for using eBooks and watching informative videos
- The bigger screen size allows you to be creative and make your subject notes in interesting and imaginative ways
- Options:
 - Different cases

Apple iPad Pro – 9.7” screens

From £31.48 per month



- The latest and most powerful iPad
- Easily research information and view eBooks, etc.
- Designed to allow you to be creative in making your notes
- The optional Apple keyboard allows you to easily type up assignments
- Options:
 - Different cases
 - 32GB, 128GB or 256GB storage
 - Apple keyboard

Apple MacBook Air – 11” or 13” screens

From £44.55 per month



- Entry level laptop from Apple
- Instant on to allow you to quickly type up notes in lessons
- Useful option if you know you'll need to type up lots of assignments
- Suitable for research and typing up work.
- Battery designed to last all day
- Options
 - 11” or 13” screens
 - 128GB or 256GB storage
 - 4GB or 8GB memory

Apple MacBook Pro – 13” screens

From £56.86 per month



- The powerhouse of the range
- Useful if you are creating multimedia work for subjects such as Digital Photography, Media Studies or Music.
- Batteries last all day
- Excellent for research and typing up notes.
- Options:
 - 128GB or 256GB storage
 - Different cases

The Lease Option

- ❑ It is a 21 month scheme and so payments are taken each month for 21 months
- ❑ A £30 deposit is taken through ParentPay. This will then give you access to the school Device Portal so that you can order the device you want
- ❑ If you decide upon an option costing more than £30 per month you will be asked to 'top-up' your deposit to cover 1 monthly payment.
- ❑ This deposit is then used as your 21st Direct Debit payment
- ❑ You then own the device after this final payment

The Upfront Option

- ❑ A £30 deposit is taken through ParentPay. This will then give you access to the school Device Portal so that you can order the device you want
- ❑ This deposit is then taken off the upfront payment
- ❑ You then own the device after the scheme ends
- ❑ With this option you get the device cheaper than the Lease option

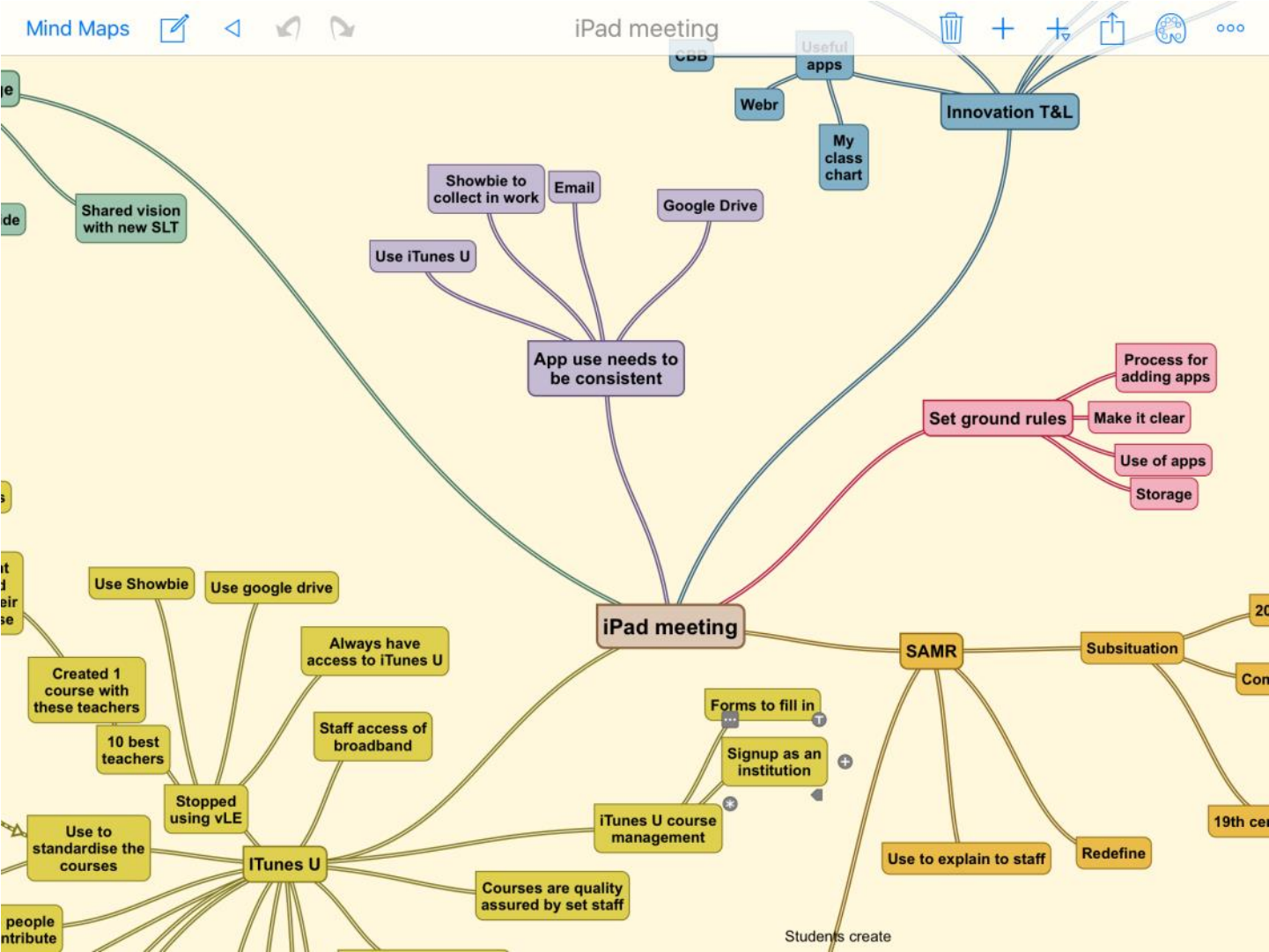
Useful apps you get for free

- ❑ Word, PowerPoint, Excel
- ❑ OneDrive with 1TB of storage
- ❑ ExplainEverything – make quick videos to explain topics
- ❑ SimpleMinds – mind mapping app
- ❑ Mail – check your school email
- ❑ Calendar – plan when things are going to happen like exams
- ❑ Tasks – list down what work you need to get done.
- ❑ TimeTable – make sure you know your lessons and any homework due.

Insurance information

- The insurance covers Accidental Damage as well as Theft and Warranty
- No excess payable if you damage the screen (Subject to a maximum of 3 incidents)
- Insurance covers the device on school trips, and family holidays abroad
- You bring the device to school to get it fixed or replaced, we handle all this for you
- Does include water damage

Cases

- ❑ Designed to withstand dropping
 - Rubber corner covers of iPads
 - Shell cases for MacBooks
- ❑ Tested by the insurance company
- ❑ Comes in a choice of colours



Timeline

- Results Day – in your pack from school you will receive a letter about the scheme. Pricing and how to sign up.
- Deposits to be paid via Parent Pay by the 9th September.
- Order your chosen device by 22nd September.
- Delivery of chosen device in the first week of October, earlier if possible.
