



The Dangers of Snap Map!

Snap Map is a new feature on Snapchat and is one of the most worrying features on any social media. It allows any snapchat user to be able to track and locate their 'friends'. Snap Map shows the name of the user, what street the user is on and how long ago they were there and, if not monitored closely, could present a real risk to any young person.

Below are the steps to turn your snap map onto 'ghost mode' which protects the user from being able to be tracked by their Snapchat friends.

1. When a Snapchat user zooms out from their home screen, it will bring up a map, which shows themselves in their current location and the location of their friends.
2. In the top right-hand corner of the screen, click the icon and it will bring up the settings feature. This will allow you to decide if you do or don't allow other users to track your location.
3. To turn off the ability for other users to track your location, you can click on the button next to 'ghost mode' to stop this.
