# The Lease Option

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- ❑ It is a 21 month scheme and so payments are taken each month for 21 months
- ❑ You will be sent a link to a Device Portal. You register and then order your device.
- ❑ School check your order.
- ❑ Ask for a Deposit to be paid via ParentPay, this will be the equivalent of one-months payment.
- ❑ This deposit is then used as your 21<sup>st</sup> Direct Debit payment
- ❑ You then own the device after this final payment



# The Upfront Option

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- You will be sent a link to a Device Portal. You register and then order your device.
- School check your order.
- Ask for a Deposit to be paid via ParentPay, this will be the equivalent of one-months payment.
- This deposit is then taken off the upfront payment.
- You then own the device after the scheme ends.
- With this option you get the device cheaper than the Lease option.

# Sixth Form Bursary

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- ❑ Sixth Form offer a Bursary scheme for students.
- ❑ If you are qualify for the Sixth Form Bursary school maybe able to help towards getting you an iPad to use during your studies.

# Timeline

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- Results Day – in your pack from school you will receive a letter about the scheme. Pricing and how to sign up.
- Link to Device Portal sent Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> September.
- Order your chosen device by Monday 18<sup>th</sup> September.
- Pay your deposit via ParentPay by Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> September.
- Delivery of chosen device in early October.

# Insurance information

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- The insurance covers Accidental Damage as well as Theft and Warranty
- No excess payable if you damage the screen (Subject to a maximum of 3 incidents)
- Insurance covers the device on school trips, and family holidays abroad
- You bring the device to school to get it fixed or replaced, we handle all this for you
- Does include water damage

# Cases

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- ❑ Designed to withstand dropping
  - Rubber corner covers of iPads
  - Shell cases for MacBooks
- ❑ Tested by the insurance company
- ❑ Comes in a choice of colours



# Useful apps you get for free

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- ❑ Word, PowerPoint, Excel
- ❑ OneDrive with 1TB of storage
- ❑ ExplainEverything – make quick videos to explain topics
- ❑ SimpleMinds – mind mapping app
- ❑ Mail – check your school email
- ❑ Calendar – plan when things are going to happen like exams
- ❑ Tasks – list down what work you need to get done.
- ❑ TimeTable – make sure you know your lessons and any homework due.

# Feedback from pilot

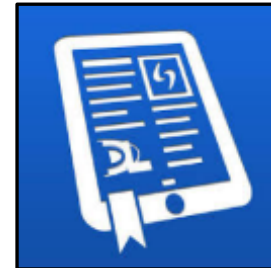
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- Useful for taking notes in lesson
