

Dear Parent/Carer

The Government has announced a staggered return to school week commencing 4<sup>th</sup> January 2021. Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January is a staff training day and students will not be in school. Students in Years 7 to 10 are to work at home and access learning online for the rest of this week.

If your child is unable to access online learning due to the lack of appropriate technology please e-mail [its@king-james.co.uk](mailto:its@king-james.co.uk) and we will endeavour to help. We have a small number of laptops we can lend out if required.

Provision will be available in school from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January to Friday 8<sup>th</sup> January (inclusive) for Year 11 and Year 13 students, students identified as vulnerable and the children of critical workers who need their child to come to school to enable the parent/carer to attend work.

Students accessing critical worker provision will remain in their year group bubble, using their current Hub during breaks and lunchtime. There will be a limited lunch menu available for purchase. Students will work in an allocated computer room accessing the ItsLearning work set by their subject teachers.
