

Proposed Residential Trips 2011/12

The school is rightly proud of the number and diversity of our extra curricular trips and visits. This section on our website is designed to help parents to understand our trips and visits and to see what might be on offer, in terms of residential trips, throughout a students' lifetime in school.

There are broadly two types of trips and visits; those that are closely related to the curriculum (for example a language exchange trip, where students stay with a host family) and those that are run as a holiday opportunity (for example a ski trip).

Many trips and visits are day trips and take place in school time. It is impossible to list here all of those trips. What we have listed below are the residential trips that we run. Please note that this is what we have done historically; it is not a guarantee that we will always run these trips in future. Some trips cease to run and new ones take their place. Residential trips and visits are run entirely at the goodwill of the teachers concerned.

The table shows the type of trip, the year group that it is aimed at, and the likely cost based on past experience. There is sometimes more demand for places than there are places available. If this is the situation we put all of the applications into a draw and operate a lottery system. We try to avoid disappointment but cannot always guarantee that we can accommodate every request to attend a trip.
