# The King James's School French Learning Journey

Discussing jobs and work preferences, career choices, applying for jobs, problems in the world, the environment, charity work, festivals, traditions and celebrations

Using verbs followed by *à/ de*, using *venir de* + infinitive, revision of direct object pronouns and the perfect tense, revision of modal verbs in the conditional tense, the subjunctive

Talking about food & meals, shopping for food, food for French festivals, ordering food, healthy living

Using the definite & indefinite articles, giving quantities, the near future tense, using *doit, faut, devrait*

Describing school subjects & giving opinions, describing school & comparing with schools in France, school rules, discussing school exchanges, healthy living, discussing drugs & alcohol  
Using the present, past and future tenses, the imperative, present tense verbs, *il faut/ il ne faut pas*

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Talking about sports and benefits, new technology (benefits and dangers), TV programmes, cinema, social activities in the past tense

Talking about your town/ village, discussing the weather, advantages and disadvantages of where you live, discussing what there is to see and do, talking about future plans

Talking about holiday activities, staying in a hotel, talking about ideal holidays, ordering food in a restaurant, buying souvenirs, describing a holiday in the past

Describing people, discussing what makes a good friend, discussing family relationships, making arrangements to go out, describing social activities, discussing role models

Using *depuis* with the present tense, making comparisons, irregular present tense verbs, using superlatives, using direct object pronouns

Talking about the future using the present tense, using the pronoun 'y', *si* clauses with the future, asking questions, negative expressions

Revision of past tense, revision of future & conditional tenses, *avant de* + infinitive, role plays

Learning about a region in France, travel arrangements, booking accommodation, a visit to an attraction

Descriptions of sports personalities, talking about what you used to do/ sports & hobbies, mystery at the castle, talking about social media, asking someone out and describing a date

Talking about illness, describing accidents and injuries, healthy living, understanding and giving advice

Using verbs with *à / de*, adjectives, using the pronoun 'y', using different tenses in sentences, revision of the conditional

The imperfect tense, adjective endings, giving opinions, revising the perfect tense with *avoir & être*

LC3 – La Santé

Expressions with *avoir & être*, reflexive verbs, using negative expressions, the imperative, revise the perfect tense

Present tense regular & irregular verbs, reflexive verbs, perfect tense using *avoir & être*, adjectival agreement

Countries & nationalities, giving details about holidays, a day out in Paris, talking about a holiday centre, what you did on your holiday

Talking about school subjects & giving opinions, talking about options, future ambitions, future education & work

Using *en/au/à* with towns and countries, forming questions, *on peut* + infinitive, perfect tense with *avoir & être*, intensifiers

*Aller* + infinitive (future tense), using *vouloir, pouvoir & devoir*, conditional + infinitive, comparative & superlative, using *si & quand* clauses

Talking about food and French meals, preparing for a party, shopping for food and eating in a restaurant

Making and reacting to invitations, making excuses, talking about clothes, shops, shopping and prices

Talking about last weekend/ yesterday, revising what you like to do, TV programmes

Definite articles after verbs of like/ dislike, how to say 'some', *il faut* + infinitive, using *de* with quantities

Modal verbs: *pouvoir, devoir, vouloir, aller* + infinitive (future tense), adjectives and agreements, comparative adjectives, giving opinions

LC2 – Temps Libre

Where people live, describing your house & town, places in a town, asking directions

Daily routine, school subjects, telling the time and school timetable, describing the weather

Talking about sports and games, musical instruments, saying what you like to do, activities at the leisure centre, giving opinions

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LC1 – On s'amuse



Reflexive verbs, intensifiers & connectives, the verb *faire*, using a range of pronouns

*jouer à/ de, faire, aimer* + infinitive, regular present tense -er verbs, pronouns, *on peut* + infinitive

Perfect tense with *avoir*, negatives with the perfect tense, irregular past tense verbs, extending and linking sentences, giving opinions using *c'était*

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The regular verbs *habiter* (-er verbs) and *aller*, towns and countries, asking questions, pronouns (*tu & vous*), prepositions

The verbs *avoir & être*, possessive adjectives, plurals, negatives, adjectives, opinions

Pronouns (*je, tu*), accents & pronunciation, verb *avoir*, definite and indefinite articles
