## YEAR 11 END OF YEAR FINAL ARRANGEMENTS

As we approach the final stages of Year 11 students' pre-16 education, I would like to inform you of attendance arrangements, school's expectations for the upcoming exam season and forthcoming key dates.

## The final day of the Year 11 timetable will be Thursday 12th May.

## Prior to the end of the Year 11 timetable

Up to Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> May lessons will continue as usual with the focus on revision and exam preparation. The written exams begin on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> May, however there may be some practical examinations prior to this date.

## Expectations of students during exam season:

The expectations of Year 11 students during the exam season will be:

- **a.** 100% attendance until Friday 13<sup>th</sup> May
- **b.** Full uniform at all times including exams
- c. Excellent behaviour and engagement
- d. Students have read and adhere to the exam rules and regulations (attached)
- e. Bring the correct equipment for each exam

From Friday 13<sup>th</sup> May, students will not be expected in school other than for exams or attending subject specific revision sessions. During the weeks beginning 16<sup>th</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> May staff will continue to support students with their revision and preparation for their summer exams during their timetabled lesson time. Students can also access revision materials and support remotely at these times. Heads of department will contact you if they are offering revision sessions after half term. Students attending any of these sessions will need to sign in at the main reception (unless they have an exam) and be in full school uniform. There will not be study areas available throughout the day during this period, however if your child lives a long way from school and may need some support in their preparation for certain exams please contact me in advance and I will look to resolve any issues.
