[Walking](#)

The location of King James's School makes it accessible from both the town centre, bus station and train station, as well as many residential areas in Knaresborough.

[Cycling](#)

Cycling is one of the easiest ways to fit exercise into your daily routine. It can save you money, keep you fit and help the environment. The school can be reached easily by bicycle and there is cycle parking available at the school. The school is close to National Cycle Route 636, which runs from Harrogate on the 'Beryl Burton Way' and then along Knaresborough's picturesque riverside.

[By Train](#)

Knaresborough train station is on the Leeds-Harrogate-York train line. Trains run from York approximately every hour and take around 25minutes. Trains run from Leeds approximately every half an hour and take around 45minutes. The train station is approximately a 10minute walk or 2½minute cycle to the school.

[By Bus](#)

The school and Knaresborough bus station are served by a number of bus links with local towns:

- The 1, 1A, 1B and 1C buses all run between Harrogate, Starbeck and Knaresborough.
- The 21 runs between Knaresborough and Boroughbridge.

Knaresborough bus station is approximately a 5 minute walk or 1½ minute cycle to the school.

[By Car](#)

Students that have to travel to and from school by car are being encouraged to Park and Stride. By road, we are only 4 miles from Harrogate, 17 miles from York and 17 miles from Leeds. The A1(M) motorway junction 47 is only 4 miles away. We have a car park, but spaces are limited and so we ask visitors to consider other travel options where possible. York Place car park (managed by Harrogate Borough Council, charges apply) is only a short walk from the school.
