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### **Student Portal to access homework**

Further to my message in the newsletter last week. I just want to remind parents and students that homework will be set on Bromcom from Monday 25th September. Parents and students will be able to view homework that has been set via MCAS and the student portal. Please can you also note that teachers might not mark work on the day it is submitted and so it might flag as 'overdue' until it has been checked by the teacher. We are working with Bromcom to try and find a solution to the 'overdue' issue. Students will receive a neutral behaviour event if homework has not been completed. There are two options for students to access the homework.

For iphones or ios devices

- 1. Download 'Bromcom Student app' in the app store (scan the QR code)
- 2. Enter a 5-digit pin code that you will need to remember
- 3. Select Magic Link and type in School ID 11433
- 4. Type in your child's school email address e.g., 18jsmith@king-james.co.uk
- 5. Go to your school email address to verify the link.

For Android phones or the internet

- 1. Log on to www.bromcomvle.com (scan the QR code)
- 2. Select Microsoft login at the bottom of the page
- 3. Type in your email address e.g. 18jsmith@king-james.co.uk
- 4. Type in the password you use to log-in to a school computer.
- 5. School ID if requested-11433
