

Explanation of Learning Cycle Report Information for Parents 2023/24

Year 13

A level targets are set using Fisher Family Trust target setting data. This comes from national prior attainment data including GCSE results. It is a single grade per subject and is set to be realistic, but aspirational.

The report also contains the teacher's forecast grade based on the work completed at that point and their judgment on the most likely outcome in the final exams.

PLEASE NOTE: This term Fisher Family Trust changed the target setting process in November 2022 due to the changes in national data caused by Covid. We are not yet intending to review the targets provided last year, since it would not change the feedback teachers provided our students regarding previous assessed work. It should also be noted that the grade boundaries were more challenging in 2023, as the awarding bodies matched performance to 2019 pre-pandemic results. This may make some student targets more challenging.

All Year 13 will have subject targets unless they have transferred to King James's in Autumn 2023.
