1	w/c 12 th February	<i>Lord of the Flies</i> – reread Chapters 1-3 Make a mindmap of key events, symbols and themes for each chapter.	
2	w/c 19 th February	<i>Lord of the Flies</i> - Reread chapters 4-6 Make a mindmap of key events, symbols and themes for each chapter. Revise descriptive devices and make a flashcard for each one with an example	
3	w/c 26 th February	<i>Lord of the Flies</i> - Reread chapters 7- 9 Make a mindmap of key events, symbols and themes for each chapter. Revise sentence types and make a flashcard for each one with an example	
4	w/c 4 th March	<i>Lord of the Flies</i> - Reread chapters 10 and 11 Make a mindmap of key events, symbols and themes for each chapter.	
5	w/c 11 th March	Read the first 7 poems in the conflict cluster and make a flashcard with key points for each one. Make a mindmap of all of the poetic devices you need to know.	
6	w/c 18 th March	Read the final 8 poems in the conflict cluster and make a flashcard with key points for each one. Make a mindmap of quotes from all poems on war, memory and nature.	
7	w/c 25 th March	Revise language devices by creating an A3 sheet. Find examples for each one. Read your language mock paper 1 and make sure you understand the questions/feedback. Time yourself for an hour and complete one of the Paper 1 section A papers. 8	w/c 1 st April	<i>Jekyll and Hyde</i> – reread Chapters 1-5 (Or Stave 1-3 of A Christmas Carol) Make a mindmap of key events, symbols, contextual knowledge and themes for each chapter.	

9	w/c 8 th April	Revise symbolism in <i>Lord of the Flies</i> and plan the following essay questions: How does Golding present ideas about society and order? How important are the hunts? How important is ritual and tribal behaviour?	
10	w/c 15 th April	<i>Jekyll and Hyde</i> – reread Chapters 6-10 (Or Stave 4-5 of A Christmas Carol) Make a mindmap of key events, symbols, contextual knowledge and themes for each chapter/Stave. Find three images (a landscape, a character and a painting) and write a plan for how you would write a descriptive response for each one.	
11	w/c 22 nd April	Reread all 15 poems. Write an essay plan for each of these questions: Compare presentation of fear in ‘Remains’ and one other poem. Compare power of nature in ‘Prelude’ and one other poem. Compare presentation of memory in ‘Poppies’ and one other poem.	
12	w/c 29 th April	Create flashcards with as many <i>Lord of the Flies</i> questions as you can think of. List quotations you could use for each one. Do the same for <i>Jekyll and Hyde/A Christmas Carol</i> .	
13	w/c 6 th May	Watch <i>Macbeth</i> (youtube) or read a summary of each scene. Create flashcards for each main characters, themes and symbols. Write an essay plan and the first two points for each of these essay questions: Why is the beast important? What does Lord of the Flies reveal about society? How does the island change over the course of the novel?	
14	w/c 13 th May	Create an A3 mindmap where you list methods each writer uses in their novel/play/poem e.g. Stevenson - pathetic fallacy, symbolism etc. Revise context for <i>Macbeth, Jekyll and Hyde, Lord of the Flies</i> and the poetry. Make a poster or flashcards so you can look at it every day between now and the exams.	
15	w/c 20 th May	Find five images online – make sure at least one is a character. Write the opening paragraph of a descriptive or narrative piece of writing for each. You may wish to revise any structures you’ve been given to help e.g. D-Z-S-L ‘Technology is bad for teenagers’ time yourself and write a 45 minute response to this question arguing for or against it.	

16	<i>w/c 27th May</i>	Look over your Paper 1 and 2 responses and write some instructions for how to answer each question.		
17	<i>w/c 3rd June</i>	<p>Time yourself and write a 45 response to the question: 'Social Media is a powerful way to bring people together' write an argument expressing your response to this statement.
