If, in the event of it being oversubscribed we will hold a ballot to allocate places. Confirmation of places will be notified to parents by text by **Monday 29th September**, the exact price will be confirmed in the text. Payment to secure their place will then be required by **12 noon on Friday 10th October** and should be made online through ParentPay (www.parentpay.com). Prior to making the payment you will be requested to complete the required consent information on ParentPay.

We place great importance on our enrichment program, and this trip promises to be a wonderful way to celebrate the end of their first term at KJS. Participation on the trip is conditional on your child maintaining our expectations of good behaviour, punctuality and attendance, which is determined by school, in the lead up to the trip. Any pupil failing this criteria in the lead up will be withdrawn from the trip. This may lead to full or partial loss of payments.
