Week beginning 17th Nov	Henry VIII rebellions. Make sure you understand the historical context around the religious changes in the reign. Revise POG really well, looking at the key areas on the pink sheet but ensuring you have detail such as names, places, statistics as this one could appear on the source question and will need to be analysed in most essays too.
Week beginning 24 th Nov	POG and Western Rebellion passages. Skills and exam practice
Week beginning 1st Dec	Rebellions under Edward and Mary. Extra detail needed on Western rebellion. Consider idea of 'Mid Tudor Crisis'. Reasons why 1549 saw so much unrest. Causes, levels of threat, government response etc.
Week beginning 8th Dec	English rebellions under Elizabeth. Learn pink sheets. Think about why there were fewer rebellions during her reign in England.
Week beginning 15 th Dec	Irish rebellions- Causes, nature, level of threat, govt response - comparisons to English ones Tyrone
Christmas Holidays	Tudor rebellions Top Trumps. Make all your family play it at Christmas Revise Henry VII rebellions. Memorise the info on the pink summary sheets. Make sure you understand the causes and levels of threat. You could make summary sheets on H 7 rebellions, one for causes, one ranking levels of threat for each and reasons why. Make sure you also give yourself time to have a Christmas break.
