EVERY LESSON

Before:

- Bring your sketchbook to every lesson even if you think you don't need it.
- You will need to work independently on finishing tasks, making improvements to work as well as completing set homework to deadlines.

During:

- Check in with your teacher about what you are intending to do during your lesson, do not wait to be asked.
- Actively engage in the lesson: listen to the teacher; participate in activities with 100% effort; make notes; share your answers/ideas; respond to feedback.
- Be ready to explain your thoughts and ideas when asked.

After:

- Independently act on feedback given at home or use study periods in the Art Department to do this.

WEEKLY

- **Homework:** details & deadlines on BromCom/Teams.
- **Read:** Independently engage with articles relating to your art practice.
- **Subject skills:** No matter what work you are doing in lesson aim to spend 30mins drawing from life every week to build these essential skills. Drawing is at the core of all creativity and should be practiced all the time.

EVERY 2 WEEKS

- **Complete annotations:** Look back through work and annotate ideas and intentions.
- **Continued development of sketchbook work.** Reflect on your progress over the last two weeks. Checking deadlines on TEAMS.
- **Continued development of subject skills, try out different mediums.**
